

## OVERVIEW 2023-2024



Proud2Be is a grassroots queer-led social enterprise that supports and enables LGBTQIA+ people in Devon (and beyond) to thrive, be free, safe, and proud to be ourselves. We aim to combat rural social isolation by creating safe, welcoming spaces where LGBTQIA+ people (and allies) can connect with their community.

Proud2Be works to:

- Provide safe spaces for LGBTQIA+ people to meet, gain mutual support and develop skills
- Provide 121 emotional and practical support for young people and adults
- Deliver awareness training for professionals in education and other settings to promote understanding in the wider community
- Host awareness-raising campaigns and events to increase positive visibility of the LGBTQIA+ community
- Provide volunteering opportunities to assist in the delivery of services and contribute to personal and professional development

### PRIDE NOT PREJUDICE

While the year brought challenges, including the threat of rising anti-LGBTQIA+ hate, the Proud2Be team was unshakeable. In 2023/24, we ran 12 different types of activities and sessions (both online and face to face) to support a total of 378 adults and young people. We reached hundreds of attendees across the UK through our training, and thousands across the world via our awareness content on social media. With the help of our community we raised £2,720 in donations towards our mission. In November 2023, we were incredibly proud to open our second hub (in Paignton) to continue our work across Torbay!


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

#### We ran 77 adult & family social group sessions




#### We gave 853 hours supporting adults





#### We supported 79 LGBTQIA+ young people



### We delivered 1700 hours of awareness training to 390 attendees across the UK
