Key Responsibilities

- Support the design and delivery of engaging, inclusive activities and projects for LGBTQIA+ people
- Be a proactive, collaborative team member—sharing ideas and valuing contributions
- Be fully committed to the freedom and liberation of all LGBTQIA+ people, especially those facing increased discrimination (e.g. trans/non-binary people, bi people, disabled people, older people, sex workers, POC, asylum seekers, and others)

Core Tasks

- Assist the team with setting up and packing away before and after the group sessions
- Help with preparing and cooking food for the group
- Facilitate crafts, games, and other group activities
- Offer a listening ear and encourage active engagement from service users
- Recognise, celebrate, and support the achievements and contributions of service users
- Adhere to Proud2Be's health and safety, safeguarding, and data protection policies

- Attend regular group supervision sessions, 121 supervisions, and contribute to monthly team days
- Check and respond to messages via email and Discord, as appropriate
- Uphold Proud2Be's values, policies, and inclusive ethos in all interactions
- Maintain appropriate boundaries and confidentiality in line with organisational guidelines
- Support the creation of a safe, welcoming, and affirming space for all service users
